Through the Children's Initiative, LLS is committed to investing \$100M into fighting pediatric cancers. Approximately, 80% of childhood cancer survivors develop one or more chronic health conditions as a result of their treatment, and in the last 40 years, only 4 oncology drugs have been approved for first use in children. By LLS standards – this is unacceptable, and LLS is disrupting the status quo with their bold vision for young patients – to not only survive their cancer but thrive in their lives after treatment.

While many children survive ALL (acute lymphoblastic leukemia), the most common type of pediatric blood cancer, the treatments are harsh and outdated. The long-term effects of current therapies can create severe life-threatening complications. Survival rates for children with other high-risk types of leukemia, such as AML (acute myeloid leukemia) like Kendall, are very poor. That's why LLS is increasing investment in pediatric research.
