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In 2000 my family lost my grandmother to ovarian cancer. She was sixty-six years old. I was nine. Other than a family dog we lost when I was five, this was the first major experience with the death of a loved one in my life. I remember her bandanas. She had one big beautiful wig that she would style at the dining room table on a foam wig head. It was blonde and had a fountain of volume. Whenever she wasn't wearing it, she was wearing a bandana.

I still remember underestimating the progression of her disease and ignoring the red flags that even I could recognize as a child. I remember the devastation and hopelessness surrounding my family as her cancer progressed. But deep down I always felt that she would beat it. When she didn't, my whole world shattered. I understood that this was the first time in my life that I had a broken heart.

I am currently on a mission to raise \$81,000 USD in the [The Leukemia & Lymphoma Society](https://www.mwoy.org/)'s Man & Woman of the Year Competition (<https://www.mwoy.org/>).
