



In 2016, an old friend and classmate of mine lost a lifelong battle with cancer. We attended preschool and elementary school together, went to countless birthday parties, and participated in the same girl scout troop. She was an amazing artist from a young age, and when she got older she tried her hand at acting. She was a beautiful human and a beautiful soul.

She was diagnosed with bone cancer when we were in fourth grade. I can still remember the bump on her knee. I think we were about nine years old because she was diagnosed not too long after my grandmother passed from ovarian cancer. She started chemo, shaved her hair, and wore bandanas just like my grandma. She came to school when she could. Looking back it was pretty remarkable how her experience taught a group of obnoxious nine-year-olds to put their differences aside, even for brief moments, to support a friend.


Over the years she had several re-diagnoses and remissions until she passed at the age of twenty-five. We reconnected a few times as young adults, and I am very grateful for those moments now. Her passing hurt in a different way. Of course it's different when the person you lose is so young, but more than that, I had always thought of her as unbeatable. I took advantage of the fact that she would always come out stronger on the other end of cancer. I never thought it would actually take her so soon.

The [LLS Children's Initiative](http://www.LLS.org/childrens-initiative) is a multi-year collaboration with a goal of raising \$100 million dedicated to advances in pediatric blood cancer treatment and services. A staggering **40% of pediatric cancers are blood cancers**, and approximately 80% of pediatric cancer survivors develop one or more chronic health conditions as a side effect of their cancer treatment. But only four oncology drugs have been approved for first use in children in the past forty years.
